Furniture and Fixture Disposition Project

Background and Rationale:

With the move of personnel from the East Building to Metro Square in early 2026, there will be a large quantity of surplus furniture and assorted other fixtures from the East Building that will require removal and disposition. Furniture includes workstations, office sets, chairs, file cabinets, shelving and miscellaneous other items that have served their useful life. These items will need to be dismantled, moved to the loading dock, and removed for recycling and disposition as appropriate. A project of this size requires a considerable amount of time and funding to complete. This work must be completed in a timely fashion to prepare the building for sale as the buyer has no interest in these items.

Resolution B2023-079 authorized the sale of the Ramsey County Care Center ('Care Center') to NUWAY Alliance. Per the resolution, proceeds from the sale were placed in a holding project as a project budget in the 2023 Capital Projects Fund. Requests for use of these funds were to be presented to the Ramsey County Board of Commissioners through the request for board action process.

Recommendation:

The Ramsey County Board of Commissioners resolved to:

- 1. Accept and approve the project budget and financing plan for the Ramsey County East Kellogg building furniture and fixture disposition project in an amount up to \$240,000.
- 2. Authorize the County Manager to allocate up to \$240,000 from proceeds from the sale of the Ramsey County Care Center to the project budget and financing plan for the Ramsey County East Kellogg building furniture and fixture disposition project.
- Authorize the County Manager to establish a project budget of \$240,000 for the Ramsey County East Kellogg building furniture and fixture disposition project in the Property Management budget.

A motion to approve was made by Commissioner McGuire, seconded by Commissioner Miller. Motion passed.
