Title

Agreement for Technical Assistance on Recycling and Solid Waste Issues

Recommendation

- 1. Approve the selection of and the agreement with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC., 2121 Innovation Court, Suite 300, De Pere, Wisconsin, 54115 for technical assistance on recycling and solid waste issues for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023, with the option to renew for up to two (2) additional one year periods, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000 per year.
- 2. Authorize the Chair and Chief Clerk to execute the agreement.
- 3. Authorize the County Manager to execute amendments to the agreement in accordance with the County's procurement policies and procedures, provided the amounts are within the limits of available funding.

Background and Rationale

Ramsey County has a role in helping ensure the continuous improvement of municipal recycling programs throughout the County. To support this role, Public Health has made consulting services available to interested public entities, such as municipalities and school districts. The services primarily focus on recycling and are consistent with County policies reflected in the County's solid waste master plans.

Since 2000, and in an effort to provide continued support to municipal recycling programs, Public Health has been contracting with a consultant to provide technical assistance to municipalities to help bolster recycling programs through the improvement of their recycling contracts. This type of service has been included as a recycling strategy in subsequent Ramsey County solid waste master plans. Beginning in 2006, the County extended its offer of this technical assistance to include any public entity within the County.

On July 15, 2020, Ramsey County released a competitive solicitation for technical assistance on recycling and solid waste issues. Below is a competitive solicitation summary.
